This correspondence is to confirm our understanding of the terms and objectives of our engagement and the nature and limitations of the services we will provide for Tower Lodge Care Center, LLC.

We will perform the following Services:

We will review the financial statement for the period ending December 2024, in accordance with Statements of Standards for Accounting and Review Services issued by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants.
